The *Adeline Ross Memorial Scholarship* is given in memory of an Episcopal Deaconess who was active in the Wind River Valley from 1915-1949. She used her own money to offer loans to students for education. In the late 1960s, Dubois resident and artist Mary Back was instrumental in creating a method to continue helping students, and arranged for a large bequest to the Fund upon her death. The principal is now invested and the interest earned is given through application to learners of all ages following specific guidelines.
